1. ESO's Very Large Telescope has captured <b>a stunning image of stars forming in the Large Magellanic Cloud.</b>	
2. The image is of a nebula called N180B, located within the LMC — <b>and is the birthplace of a host of new stars.</b>	
3. N180B's distinctive shape is made up of a <b>collection of giant bubbles.</b>	
4. One of the young stars was <b>spotted emitting a jet.</b>	
5. This is the <b>first time a jet like this has been observed at visible wavelengths</b> outside our galaxy...	
6. ...thanks to the <b>relatively low amount of dust in the LMC.</b>	
7. The jet, <b>named Herbig-Haro 1177</b> , is teaching astronomers more about the <b>early lives of stars, both large and small.</b>
